Types of Rabies

- 1. <u>Furious (Aggressive) Rabies:</u> agitated, irritable, unpredictable, viciously aggressive
- 2. <u>Paralytic (Dumb) Rabies:</u> inability to swallow, salivation, drooping of lower jaw, paralysis, coma, stumbling


It is impossible to tell if an animal has rabies! Even without the presence of symptoms an animal can transmit the virus to others.



- **❖Bat exposure**
- DHEC only notified when victim was presenting symptoms at hospital
